



# 2010-2011 "SCOUTS PLAY IT SAFE" AT SAFETY TOWN For Brownie and Wolf Scouts



**THE PROGRAM:** Brownie Girl Scout Troops and Wolf Cub Scout Dens are invited to participate in "Scouts Play It Safe" at Safety Town, 1320 Aurora Ave. Naperville, sponsored by the Naperville Junior Woman's Club, the Naperville Police Department, and the Naperville Fire Department. This Brownie and Wolf program will provide an overview of pedestrian, bicycle and fire safety, how and when to call 911, and how to handle strangers. The following requirements will be met:

**Brownies** - The program will cover part of the Brownie Safety Try-It (Street Safety and Fire Safety requirements). It will also address safety topics including stranger danger, calling 911, crime awareness, and fire safety as described in the "Staying Safe" section of the Brownie Girl Scout Handbook

**Wolves** - The program will cover requirements 4B, C, D, F and 9C, D, E and 12C, E, G & H. Additionally, the Scouts will be given the *tools* necessary to complete 4A and 9B. Work will also be completed towards the Crime Prevention Award.

Registrations must include one check per group made payable to *Naperville Safety Town Commission*. The cost is \$3 per scout. Please rank in order of preference the sessions below. Only rank sessions that you can attend. We will send you a confirmation email by October 1<sup>st</sup> informing you of which session you are scheduled for. A maximum of 50 scouts per class session will be scheduled. Please estimate numbers accurately. We will be unable to change your reservation or give refunds once this form is submitted. A Safety Town patch will be distributed to each scout upon completion of the program.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Each scouting group must have at least one adult chaperone per six children. Leaders are responsible for the behavior of their group. All adults are requested to help the facilitator as needed. Groups must be Brownies or Wolves within School District #203 or #204 boundaries. **We regret that we are unable to accommodate siblings.** Only Scouts and their respective leaders may attend. Please help us by making arrangements for other children.
